The Healing Pathway provides training and guidance to students wishing to develop the skills of Healing Touch. Healing Touch is a bio-field therapy-based approach to health and healing, first formalized by the American Holistic Nurses Association and developed into the Healing Pathway by Naramata Centre.

This entry-level workshop will train participants in grounding and centering skills, focusing of bio-field energy for the healing of others, self-healing, meditation, and practical techniques for balancing, pain relief, energetic first aid, and stress reduction.

The work will draw on the wisdom of hands-on energy healing practices from a variety of faith traditions, including Hindu, First Nations, Buddhist, and Christian.
