Recognition Awards Criteria

The Conference Planning Committee invites members of the campus community to put forward names of women for this year's Recognition Awards. Nominees should meet some or all of the following criteria:

- **leadership:** nurturing special projects and/or creating a supportive and inclusive environment
- **contribution and impact:** on UVic and its communities, especially in the interests of women
- **outstanding performance:** in her role as a student, faculty, staff, alumna or member of the UVic community

Format Requirements

The Conference Planning Committee grants awards for individual recognition in these areas and bases its decisions strictly on the quality of the nominations and supporting documents. It is the responsibility of the nominators to provide relevant information. The package is copied to each member of the Awards Committee. Therefore, all submissions must be forwarded as follows; otherwise they cannot be considered.

- Supporting material must be single-sided and preferably typed on white letter-size (8.5" X 11") paper.
- Nomination packages will not be returned, so do not include original materials.

Nominees from previous years who did not receive awards are eligible for re-nomination.

The deadline for receipt of nomination forms and supporting documentation is **4 pm, Monday, December 15, 2008**. The Awards Committee will adjudicate the nominations, and awards will be presented at the UVic Women's Conference on February 18, 2009 in the University Centre Auditorium. The decision of the committee, members of which are ineligible for the awards, will be final.

A complete nomination package must include:

1. Nomination Form

Please detach nomination form (back page), complete, and include in nomination package.

2. Statement of Nomination (*maximum two pages*)

Describe why this nominee merits a UVic Women's Conference Recognition Award.

3. Short Biographical Outline (*approximately 150 words*)

Highlights should be relevant to the criteria described in this nomination form. Biographies will be edited for inclusion in the UVic Women's Conference Program; nominees will have the opportunity to approve their content. Introductions of nominees at the Conference presentation will be edited from the nomination package material.

4. Background Sketch (*maximum two pages*)

Provide an outline of the nominee's background, education, training, activity or organizational involvement, recognitions, awards or achievements. This may (but not necessarily) be in the form of a resumé or curriculum vitae.

5. Letters of Support

Provide a maximum of two letters in direct support of this nomination from individuals unrelated to the UVic Women's Conference Planning Committee or Awards Committee. Letters should be addressed to the Awards Committee Chair.
