

## **INFORMATION FOR THE CHEMISTRY 101 FALL 2013 FINAL EXAMINATION**

1. **DATE AND TIME: Friday, December 13, 2013, 9:00am-noon (3 hours), in McKinnon Gym AND DTB A120. Students with LAST NAMES beginning with letters U to Z please go to room DTB A120 (formerly called SSM A120) to write your exam.**
2. **YOUR STUDENT ID CARD is essential.** Place it at the right hand corner of your desk.
3. **Students will sit in pre-assigned seats, in alphabetical order, by surname. Find the desk that has your name sheet on it. Sign the name sheet. It will be collected during the exam. Do not use it for scrap paper. It will be collected anyway.**
4. Leave your notes, back-pack and other personal belongings (but not any valuables) at the front or back wall of the gym.
5. **NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE PERMITTED** other than the simple calculator specified for the course. Cell phones and pagers, and devices with headphones, earphones or ear buds must be off and on the floor under your desk or in your bag.
6. **NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE IN THE LAST 15 MINUTES** of the exam period. This is so that the room remains quiet for those wishing to use the full time productively.
7. The exam will be supervised at all times. This includes monitoring by invigilators of visits to the washrooms and hallways.

### **8. REVIEW SESSIONS**

**There will be three review sessions. They are all open to any Chemistry 101 students.**

These usually involve going over questions on old final exams by request from you.

9. **The examination will cover material from the whole course.** (It doesn't include specific lab material.). The style will be similar to the recent midterm test, which means that the final exam will be composed entirely of multiple choice questions. A data sheet is supplied as usual.
10. Fill out your **LAST NAME, FIRST NAME**, and student ID number (**the last 7 digits of your V0... ID number**) on the optical sense form (bubble sheet) and **bring a soft pencil** for coding these bubble sheets. **DO NOT SHADE BUBBLES FOR ANY OTHER INFORMATION.** No course, no section, no date etc.
11. **FINAL GRADES** will be available in your on-line transcript very soon after they are submitted to Records Services, but the processing of grades takes at least a week or more after the exam has been written.
