

Undergraduate Student Positions at the Water and Aquatic Research Lab

We are looking for enthusiastic and hardworking undergraduate students to fill research assistant positions for 4 to 8 months, starting in the coming term, in one of the top water research laboratories in Canada.

Students must have excellent grade averages (B+ or better) and with courses in microbiology and general biology. Positions involve assistance in the preparation of fish and zooplankton (drying, grinding and packing) samples for stable isotope analyses and assistance with microbiological water research, which involves media preparation, isolation bacteria, PCR analyses and data entry/analyses.

Salary ranges from \$1500 to \$1800 per month depending upon the undergraduate academic years. Preference will be given to applicants with related experience and coursework in microbiology (Micro 200 required). Biosafety and WHMIS certifications from the University of Victoria (can be obtained after start date).
