Taught by Dr. Brian Starzomski, ES470: Biodiversity & Conservation of Coastal BC will cover identification of coastal biodiversity, ecological methods and theory, and conservation on BC's Central Coast. Field cost is \$1000, with funding available to offset this fee. **Fieldwork-** The course is taught outdoors in the beautiful natural environment of Calvert island, part

of the Hakai Luxvbalis Conservancy. We stay at the research station of our partner, the Hakai Beach Institute. There are numerous field trips. **Ecology field methods-** Students will be required to complete a scientific project that, through observational or experimental methods, answers a question of ecological interest. **Plants & Wildlife-** Calvert island and

Hakai Luxvbalis Conservancy are home to amazing plants, wolves, orcas, humpback whales, sea lions, mink, black-tailed deer, and more than 75 species of birds. You will learn to identify them all.
